

Infos zu Ilan Gur-Ze'ev's Vortrag

Ilan Gur-Ze'ev, Philosophieprofessor an der Universität Haifa, bekannt durch zahlreiche Publikationen, insbesondere auf dem Gebiet der kritischen Erziehung und Pädagogik (siehe CV), ist am Dienstag, 7. September 2010 (20.00, Clubraum 1-3), im neu eröffneten Gemeindehaus der ICZ an der Lavaterstrasse 33 zu Gast. Abstract

Until recently the "new anti-Semitism" as a phenomenon received its visibility, a proper name and reactions almost exclusively within the prism of reaction to the growing critique of Israeli policies and in face of a new, unconcealed delegitimization of the very existence of the State of Israel. Normally, under the flag of "the new anti-Semitism" an attempt is made to unveil the roots of an alleged unfair critique, even hatred, of Israel. In my lecture I will show that what we are actually facing here is a challenge of much higher magnitude, immensely richer, rooted profoundly deeper; a grave *threat to mankind as a whole* in the present historical moment. Specifically to the Jews it inflicts new challenges that the humanist tradition and the history of the Jewish people did not prepare us to address. In my lecture I will try to offer some guidelines to a proper addressing of this new challenge.

CV Ilan Gur-Ze'ev

Ilan Gur-Ze'ev is a professor of education in the University of Haifa. He is an involved philosopher and for many years an activist and a critic of Israeli society and its culture. Professor Gur-Ze'ev is one of the leading figures in critical education and internationally known for his contribution to Critical Pedagogy with translations of his work to Arabic, German, Portuguese, Polish, Danish, English and the Croatian language. The new anti-Semitism became his focal research arena in the last couple of years. Among his books:
